Dear Parents of St. Luke students:

The children's choirs of St. Luke Parish (including the Seraphim choir and Cherub choir), will have their first rehearsals of the school year on Wednesday, September 11 and Thursday, September 12, respectively.

Please note information about rehearsal locations:

The **Seraphim Choir** (grades 5-8) will rehearse **in the Hospitality House (formerly known as the convent building)** - entering through the parking lot door. We will meet at the Hospitality House on **Wednesdays** at 3:10 p.m. for a brief snack, and then rehearse until 4:15 p.m.

The **Cherub Choir** (grades 1-4) will gather at 3 p.m. on **Thursdays** in Waldron Hall. **From there, we will go as a group to the Hospitality House**, (formerly known as the convent building), where they will have a light snack, and some relaxation time before we begin our rehearsal. The actual rehearsal will begin at 3:30 p.m. and end at 4:15 p.m. At the end of rehearsal, you will need to come into the Hospitality House to pick up your child. There is a sign-out sheet that all parents must sign each time they retrieve their child.

The choirs will sing at the 9 a.m. mass once a month, including on Christmas Eve and Palm Sunday, and we will be singing and playing music of various styles, languages and cultures.

Along with an enthusiastic student involvement in these choirs, we need the participation of parent volunteers, as well. We need adult volunteers to be present with me at each Cherub choir rehearsal to assist students when the need arises. In past years, we've had a schedule of parents who volunteered to provide the snacks for a particular Thursday, and assisted with the choir on that same day. If you would be available and willing to volunteer in this capacity, please indicate this on the form that is included with this letter. Or, if you could volunteer to assist at the Sunday mass, please indicate that.

Along with this letter is a schedule of dates on which the choirs will provide music, as well as a form that delineates the requirements of choir membership. It also requests information that is needed for the security of your child. Included are questions regarding emergency and cell phone numbers, and the identity of persons designated to meet your child at the conclusion of rehearsal. Please print and complete this form and your child may return it to their teacher, bring it to the first choir rehearsal, or return it to the rectory by Thursday, September 19.
